Dear Parents and students,

I am pleased to take this opportunity to write to you as we are fast approaching the end of an extremely busy but a very productive term and academic year! Term III exams come to an end today.

The next week and a half will be dedicated to the final rehearsals of the upcoming musical as well as going through the exam papers. It is extremely important for the students to be present in school during these days. Costumes to all students will be distributed only on **12th July**. These have been tried for fitting by the students. You may make any minor adjustments yourself if you feel it is needed for your child.

16th July 2019 (Tuesday) *What to expect during rehearsals at TFA....*

1. Everyone (excluding a few admin staff) should reach TFA between 7:30 am and 7:50 am. Students must be in their PE attire and must carry their student ID with them.
2. Those who reach school by van or private transport, please ask your van operators or otherwise to drop ad pick you up from TFA itself.
3. Rehearsals will be on till 2:30pm. A vegetarian lunch is being organised by the food committee for all students. Students may bring in light snacks like biscuits etc as long as it is vegetarian. Please bring along a water bottle too.
4. If your child needs transportation on the day of the rehearsal, please let us know by return email. We are looking at alternate transport arrangements for a handful of students.

17th July 2019 (Wednesday) *What to expect on the Day of the Play...*

1. No school in the morning for all students and office will be closed too. Main cast and some teachers will reach TFA by 3pm for makeup and hair.
2. Rest of team and students must be at the venue by **4:30 pm in their costumes with their makeup and hair done from home as has been advised previously.**
3. The play will start on time at 6pm. We are hoping that the curtain call will be by 8pm so that everyone can leave by 8:30pm.
4. Light finger food is being organised by the food committee but as on the day of the rehearsal, students may bring in some like vegetarian snacks for themselves.
5. Parking around the Temple of Fine Arts can be a challenge. You may park either at NU Sentral or at the Multi-Level Public parking at Kompleks TLK Brickfields and walk over to the Venue. Both are about 7 to 10 minutes walking distance away.

18th July 2019 (Thursday) *Rest Day for students...*

1. Rest day for students.
2. Teachers and all staff will be in school by 10 am to finalise and print transcripts, clean up and organise before the term closes.

19th July 2019 (Friday) *Annual Prize Giving day and Parents Teachers Day*

1. Last day of term for students.
2. Class teachers will inform the prize winners receiving certificates on the Prize Giving Day. This program will be from 8:00 am till 9:30 am.
3. We will be sending you an invite in due course. But please be reminded that this is also the day when you receive the transcripts form TERM III examinations. Transcript books will be distributed to parents from 10:00 am till 12:30 noon. If for some reason you are unable to come on this day, you may collect the transcripts from the office for the holidays.
