

AGREEMENT
(For provision of Transportation Services)
between
PARENT & STUDENT
and
TiS-recommended Transport Operator

Students & Parents Responsibilities:

Students will have a safer trip if the Transport Operator and their drivers can concentrate on driving, not discipline.

Therefore, it is important to note that riding the school bus is a privilege not a right, for that reason, students are expected to abide by the following school bus rules and regulations:

1. Students must follow all instructions and requests provided by the bus driver.
2. Students must follow all bus safety procedures.
3. Students must board and exit the bus properly and safely. Students must not go under the bus for any reason.
4. Students must take their assigned seats, if applicable, and remain in their seats. The bus driver reserves the right to move a student's seat if that student is acting in a disruptive manner. Students will keep the aisles clear and keep entire body inside the bus.
5. There will be absolutely no tampering with bus equipment, doors, windows, gears, etc. at any time — especially when waiting for departure.
6. Students will keep their hands off others.
7. Students must be polite and courteous to one another. Bullying will not be tolerated (verbal, physical, cyber, etc.). Students shall talk quietly, and not use vulgar or abusive language.
8. The following behavior will not be tolerated:
 - Throwing objects outside/inside the bus.
 - Eating any food or gum chewing.
 - Fighting, tripping, shoving, cursing, yelling or shouting.
9. Students are allowed to bring bottled water, which must be kept in their bag. No other types of drinks are allowed.
10. Students must depart the bus at their designated bus stop unless a note is signed by parent/guardian, has been turned into the School Admin Office / Student Transportation Department.
11. Students are prohibited from carrying weapons, tobacco, alcohol, drugs or anything else prohibited by school on the bus. Students, who violate this rule, may be reported to the Police department.

12. Students must follow all student code of conduct as described in the applicable Student Handbook.

When a student chooses to deviate from appropriate behavior, the steps for consequences will be as follows:

- First Infraction: The student will receive a warning, which will include a telephone call home to parent/guardian by the school personnel or bus driver.
- Second Infraction: The student will be suspended from bus privileges for one (1) school day.
- Third Infraction: The student will be suspended from bus privileges for (5) five school days.
- Fourth Infraction: The student will be suspended at least twenty (20) school days (approximately one month) or the remainder of the semester, whichever is longer.

Note: The student is required to attend school on the days of bus suspension. Absences during bus suspension are not excused absences. The parent must make all necessary arrangements to make sure that the student attends school.

Student Liability: Students who violate this policy its rules of conduct may be denied busriding privileges. Students who harm persons or damage any school property may be suspended or expelled from school. Students may also be reported to the Police Department.

Parent Liability: Students and bus riders who damage community property will be held liable for those damages, according to law. In the case of minor children, their parents/guardians are liable. Parents/guardians may be billed for the cost of damage.

Transporter Responsibilities:

A School Bus Driver, or Bus Driver, is in charge of s providing safe transport for school children based on a schedule and route. Their duties include helping students board the bus, learning which students take their route and planning around traffic during trips.

School Bus Driver duties and responsibilities

A School Bus Driver interacts daily with children and serves as their trusted transportation to and from school. As such, a School Bus Driver should be free of any traffic or criminal violations and should have an authoritative, yet calming demeanour and a strong understanding of traffic laws. The responsibilities and duties of the School Bus Driver position, which may include the following:

- Transport children and other passengers to and from school
- Obey all traffic laws
- Maintain a clean and mechanically sound bus at all times. (e.g., seat belts & A/C working condition)
- Ensure the safety of all students
- Verify permissions for children who ride home with friends
- Assist students with getting on and off the bus as needed
- Discipline children as needed to maintain a safe environment
- Perform inspections of the bus before and after each route
- Attend safety meetings as required.
- Provide live CCTV cam surveillance.

Agreement Terms

I understand that in the event of a significant difference between planned transportation fuel costs and actual costs, TiS-recommended Transport Operators may add a surcharge to the contract costs.

I understand that bus service is being offered subject to space and routing limitations.

I understand that a student's bus privileges can be suspended for unacceptable behavior.

I understand that routes and stops are subject to change.

I understand that by submitting this Transportation Agreement we release, hold harmless, and exonerate Tanarata International Schools from any liability which may occur from the use of transportation services by TiS-recommended Transport Operators.

TiS will however endeavour work with TiS-recommended Transport Operators to comply with all road safety rules and regulations and to ensure good operating conditions of vehicles and compliance with regulations.
