IGCSE Results for June 2023 Examinations

Let me begin by sharing with you the happy news of excellent results by our outgoing class of 2022-23. We had 90 students of our own and 6 private candidates from Year 9, 10 and 11 sitting for a total of 295 papers in 20 subjects of which 64% scored either an A* or an A! 90% of all of our students who sat have at least an A* or an A grade. This is phenomenal as CAIE has been trying to adjust the grades to get back to the pre pandemic levels. Please read the statement by CAIE in the link below.

Note to New Students and their parents

1. Orientation for all new students

Date: 29th Aug 2023 (Tuesday) Time: 8 am - 10.00 am Venue: School MPH for new students from Year 1-3. New Students (with their parents) joining us in other classes will be met by their class teachers on the same day.

- 2. To enhance the security aspects and minimize the likelihood of unauthorized person/s entering the campus, we have been issuing school car security stickers. Each family is entitled to two such stickers which should be collected personally from the security guard house after providing your vehicle registration number/s for school records. It is mandatory that every car entering the school premises to drop off or to pick up students have the car sticker clearly visible on the vehicles' windscreen.
- 3. Parents visiting the campus on the first day may wait at the café.

Parking and Traffic Flow Reminders

As you may know, traffic congestion during the peak times during the start of school and dismissal causes a gridlock at the entrance to the school. We ask again that parents and students obey traffic laws, demonstrate common courtesy, comply with our guards and parking attendants, and think SAFETY FIRST.

We encourage parents to choose to drop off and pick up their children from the parking area in the campus. Proper use of this area will decrease traffic congestion in the parking lots and reduce headaches. Above all, *please be courteous, considerate and patient.*

Parents wanting to walk into the campus to help their chidren into the classrooms will be allowed to do so only during the first week. After this period, parents are advised to walk with them only till the green gate closest to the old building and not beyond that into the clasrooms. We would like to encourage students to become independant and responsible.

Shifting of Classes /Teachers

In the new academic year you might find that your child has been moved to a different class. This shifting and movement is done randomly. Requests for shifting of class from A to B or the other way around will not be honoured. Once your child has been placed in a classroom, they will remain there for the remainder of the year, barring extenuating circumstances. All our teachers are qualified and prepared to teach both classes. If you should have questions, please check in with your child's teacher regarding their progress or send me an email.

Parent Involvement in School

Tanarata has thrived due to a strong and positive influence from our parent community. As always, this year too, we will be focusing on a number of areas, including,
