



Dear Parents and students,

As the academic year comes to a close, we would like to extend our warm gratitude to everyone who supported us throughout the journey. With the end of the academic year comes a range of exciting activities including the staging of our own musical production of "The King and I" that we are excitedly looking forward too.

Today is the last day of Term III exams for all levels. If your child has been away during this period due to any family or medical emergency and you have already notified us, then we will grade them based on class and home work done during the term.

End of Exam Activities in School - from 30th June till 6th July

Following the end of the exams, it's now time for full rehearsals to be carried in school for the staging of the musical. We are very excited about this production as a lot of time and hard work has gone into it. Please ensure that your children are present in school. During this period, we will,

- Review exam papers
- Have Class parties and picnics
- Students may bring in their board games to play within their peer groups during the waiting period before being called on stage.
- Costumes will be sent home on 5th July with the students

End of Exam Activities at TFA – On 7th and 8th July

In my previous newsletter, I had informed that on the day of the **stage rehearsals (7th July. Friday)**, we will follow school timings for all students, but students must go to TFA, Brickfields.

- We expect all the students to be at the Venue latest by 8am. Transporters may send the students to the venue directly on 7th July. The schools security guards should be there by 7:30 am.
- Students are to come in their PE attire and must have their ID card on them.
- The school will be providing meals for all students at the venue. TFA has a strict no outside food policy. All food sold at the premises are also vegetarian.
- Students may bring in their water bottles only.

- Please arrange to pick your children up from 2pm onwards in a staggered manner till 2:30pm. Teachers will be at the venue to ensure the safety of all students.

On **8th July (Saturday)**, the day of the actual show, we are asking the students to arrive at the venue in a staggered manner. This is so that makeup can be applied for the main cast and others. Please see the makeup schedule that has been attached to this email. We will also be uploading directions and details of basic makeup and hair-do to be done at home on teamie for the actual date.

- Students must take a good meal before they arrive at the venue even though we have arranged for snacks to be provided at the auditorium we find that when students are excited and nervous, they forget to eat.
- Please bring in your water bottles only as TFA is very strict on outside food policy.

We expect no delay in the start of play at 5pm. Parents and guardian are to be seated after the doors open at 4.30pm. Since parking is an issue at TFA, please arrange to carpool with other parents. Public parking is available at DBKL and Nu Sentral. We have arranged with RELA to accommodate parents around the venue. The musical is expected to be about 3 hours long followed by the curtain call. Please be patient during dismissal. Do inform your child's class teacher before taking them back home.

At this point, I would like to thank the TCC Committee members for organising some lights snacks at the venue for the audience alone. This will be during the intermission of 15 minutes between Act 1 and 2. The funds that have been collected during the various fund raising activities in school is being used for this purpose. Parents, please don't look for your children during this time, they will be well taken care off backstage by the teachers.
