4. Shifting of Classes /Teachers

Cashless Payment System

We also have an exciting new update for you. The school has collaborated with epos and is now in the process of setting up a **cashless payment system in the cafeteria**. We will send you more details on this, including instructions on how to manage and top up your virtual wallet. To make any purchase in the cafeteria, students will need to have their student ID card with them.

6. Parking and Traffic Flow Reminders

As you may know, traffic congestion during the peak times during the start of school and dismissal causes a gridlock at the entrance to the school. We ask again that parents and students obey traffic laws, demonstrate common courtesy, comply with our guards and parking attendants, and think SAFETY FIRST.

We encourage parents to choose to drop off and pick up their children from the parking area in the campus. Proper use of this area will decrease traffic congestion in the parking lots and reduce headaches. Above all, please be courteous, considerate and patient.

Parents wanting to walk into the campus to help their children into the classrooms will be allowed to do so only during the first week. After this period, parents are advised to walk with them only till the green gate closest to the old building and not beyond that into the classrooms.
