Dear Parents,

Thank you for considering **Tanarata International Schools (TiS)** for your child's education. We're glad to help you get started, and we look forward to the opportunity to work with your child to develop and achieve their full potential.

Admission is based on a number of criteria, usually including placement tests, and class sizes are limited at every level — so we recommend applying early. Admission decisions are generally made 3–4 months before the September start of the academic year, so applications should ideally reach us by **end of March** (and no more than 12 months ahead of the intended admission date).

Please provide official school records for the previous two school years; secondary school applicants must include an official transcript. If we can help with any questions along the way, don't hesitate to reach out.

- For students requiring a Student Pass, TiS does not submit the application on the family's behalf, but will assist with supporting documentation (visa validity of at least 3 months required).
- Students already on a Dependant Pass do not need a Student Pass and are eligible for direct enrollment.

Data Privacy Notice

PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT 2010 (MALAYSIA)



The Personal Data Protection Act 2010 ("PDPA") regulates how personal data is processed by data users in commercial transactions, to safeguard the interests of data subjects. The Personal Data Protection Regulations 2013 clarify five core principles:

- **General Principle** — consent from a data subject may be given in any form that can be properly recorded and maintained.

ACADEMIC YEAR 2026–27



An **application fee** of **RM 900** covers the administrative cost of processing an enrollment application.

Once a student is granted admission, a once-only **admission (entrance) fee** is payable, together with a **refundable deposit** to confirm the place:

The deposit is refundable only if the student leaves after giving one term's (i.e. 4 months) written notice to the school.

A **Resource Fund Contribution** of RM 600 per term is payable alongside tuition fees (12 terms, or 4 years, total). There are 3 terms per academic year.

A 10% discount on tuition fees applies to siblings of a current student.

GOOD TO KNOW

- **Term schedule:** three terms per year, beginning in August, January, and April.
- **Payment schedule:** tuition and resource fund fees are due 30 days before the start of each term. Students admitted in the second half of a term are charged half the basic term fee; no further reduction applies for later admission. Term fees are non-refundable once a student has started the term.
- **Late charges:** fees must be paid no later than 30 days before the start of term. A cumulative late charge of 5% per month applies after a two-week grace period, and the student may not continue attending classes until the account is current.
- **Family discount:** the eldest child is charged the full basic term fee; each subsequent sibling receives a 10% discount, across both Primary and Secondary divisions.
- **Fee adjustments:** TiS does not apply automatic annual increases. Fees are reviewed periodically by school management and take effect as needed.

- **Miscellaneous costs:** uniforms, textbooks, exercise books, and activities run by external providers (e.g. karate, drama, dance, tae-kwon-do) are paid directly to those providers, not to the school, unless TiS notifies you of a change.

PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Payment may be made by cheque (drawn on a local bank, in Ringgit Malaysia), direct bank transfer, or cash deposit at the school's bank — please provide a copy of the transaction record to the Registrar. Any bank charges arising from payments made outside these methods will be charged to the student's account.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. All tuition and fees are invoiced in Ringgit Malaysia (RM) only.
2. An invoice is issued for all tuition and fees, payable by the date shown. After 15 days of non-payment (grace period), a 5% per month compounded late charge applies. After 30 days, the school may withhold all records and take appropriate action, including prohibiting attendance and/or de-enrollment.
3. Payment may be made by local-bank cheque or bank transfer in RM, or by cash deposit into the school's bank account with the appropriate documentation provided to the school office. Cash is not accepted at the Registrar's office. Bank or transaction charges arising from other payment methods are charged to the student's account.
4. Parents remain responsible for timely payment even where fees are paid by, or reimbursable from, a third party.
5. Deposit refunds are issued only on written request, with a minimum one term's (4 months) notice of de-enrollment.
6. Parents may not engage a TiS staff member to provide services (e.g. tuition or training) to them or their child without the Principal's prior written permission. A breach may lead to expulsion of the family's child(ren) and disciplinary action against the staff member involved.
7. The school reserves the right to disenroll a student at any time, for any reason, at its sole discretion; in that event, it will refund the balance of term fees (pro-rated) and the deposit sum, less any deductions.
